I – POLICY

The Nova Scotia Curling Association (NSCA) is required, each year, to pay an affiliation fee, which is calculated based on the number of sheets of ice in affiliating curling facilities located within our province, to be paid to the Canadian Curling Association (CCA).

This fee entitles the NSCA to all the privileges associated with being a member of the CCA.

By extension, this also entitles all affiliating curling facilities within the jurisdiction of the NSCA to all programs and services made available by the CCA.

A facility cannot choose to affiliate with NSCA only and thereby avoid any CCA fees.

Because all member associations collectively are the CCA, it is impossible to separate the privileges associated with a curling facility's affiliation to them from the privileges associated with affiliation to the national body.

II – MEMBER CLUB ASSESSMENTS

Member clubs are required to submit a list of all members as of December 1st to the NSCA no later than December 15th.

Member clubs will also submit a list of all new members joining the club between December 2nd and February 15th to the NSCA no later than March 1st.

Each member club will pay a fee to the NSCA as follows:

- \$ per sheet of ice plus
- \$ times the two-year rolling average number of adult players plus
- \$ times the two-year rolling average number of Junior players plus
- \$ times the two-year rolling average number of Little Rock members
- No member club will pay more than the lesser of
 - % increase over the previous year or
 - \$ increase over the previous year
