

NSCA Joyce Myers Merit Award

Awarded for Life Time contributions to the game of Curling.

Background

Joyce Myers was a curler who influenced curling at many levels. She was an accomplished competitor, representing Nova Scotia a number of times in ladies and mixed competitions. She instilled a love of curling in those she coached and in many the drive and ability to become champions. As an official she led the way in developing competitions to the high level of fair play that exists today. Joyce organized officiating at many Provincial, Canadian and World championships. Joyce served on the executive of her club, as well as provincial and national curling associations resulting in the betterment of the sport.

The Joyce Myers Award will be conveyed upon the person who best exemplifies the ideals that Joyce stood for as a successful athlete, coach, official and builder in the sport of curling. A person who contributes in any or all of these areas can be nominated.

Eligibility & Selection Criteria

Any member, male or female, of a Nova Scotia curling club, which is a member of the Nova Scotia Curling Association (NSCA). Each member club can bring forward one nominee each year. Current Board of Directors of the Nova Scotia Curling Association are not eligible.

Curler - Can be an individual who is a competitor or participant in the sport of curling who deserves recognition for their accomplishments.

Builder - An individual who has made a significant contribution to the development of the sport of curling either regionally, provincially or nationally. This may include but is not limited to officials, coaches, club executives or curling association executives.

- Nominations must be in writing and a description of the nominee's accomplishments provided with dates and appropriate details.
- The nominations are to be sent to the NSCA office to the attention of the Joyce Myers Award Selection Committee, and will only be opened by that committee.
- The nominations are to be received by **March 1st** to be eligible for the current season.
- The Selection Committee can ask the nominator for clarification or additional information if it is not clear from the nomination form.

All nominations must be received by no later than March 1 at 4:00 p.m. annually
