Several years ago, Curling Canada and the CAC shifted the method in which coaches are trained and evaluated. Level 1, 2, and 3 —Technical, Theory and Practical have been re-vamped and is now expired terminology. There are now 4 levels of coaching. There is: Club Coach Youth, Club Coach, Competition Coach Introduction and Competition Development. At the time of this change, coaches with the previous Levels certification were transferred over to the new system. Within the new Competition Stream, there are three levels of certification:

- "In Training" when a coach has completed some of the required training for a context;
- "Trained" when a coach has completed all required training for a context;
- "Certified" when a coach has completed all evaluation requirements for a context

All coaches whose Levels NCCP qualifications are transferred to the new NCCP must complete the appropriate Make Ethical Decision Making Course and Evaluation by January 1, 2019. MED Training is only required once, and it is offered in several different environments:

- Competition Coach Introduction
- Club Coach: Youth
- Club Coach

Please note that while the MED course is mandatory, the MED Evaluations are only required for Competition Coach Introduction and Competition Development level coaches.
