Purpose: Define NSCA's requirements for a Nova Scotia representative on the CC Board.

Definitions: N/A

Policy Statement:

It is the policy of the Nova Scotia Curling Association (NSCA) that any person aspiring to be nominated for election to the Curling Canada (CC) Board of Governors must:

- Be a member in good standing of an NSCA-affiliated curling club at the time of nomination submission to Curling Canada;
- Have served for a full two-year term on the Board of Directors of the NSCA within the past eight (8) years;
- Submit a personal nomination profile to the Secretary of the NSCA and be prepared to make a presentation at a NSCA Board of Directors' Meeting soliciting the Board's endorsement of their nomination. If the NSCA Board of Directors endorses the nomination, the Secretary shall prepare a letter of recommendation on behalf of the NSCA;
- If elected to the Curling Canada Board of Governors immediately tender their resignation if also serving as a member of the NSCA Board of Directors. A person serving on the NSCA Board of Directors shall not serve on the Curling Canada Board of Governors concurrently.
