Policy Statement:

One voting delegate of NSCA shall attend the National Curling Conference and Curling Canada Annual General Meeting each year. The voting delegate shall normally be the President or Vice-President.

In the event of a Special General Meeting of Curling Canada, separate from the National Curling Conference, the official voting delegate of NSCA shall normally be the President or Vice-President.

Should either the President or the Vice-President be unable to attend the National Curling Conference and/or the Curling Canada Annual General Meeting and/or any Special Meeting of Curling Canada, an alternate may be chosen from the remaining Officers, Directors or Executive Director of NSCA by specific motion of the Board.

If the subject or ambit of any Curling Canada meeting or Congress is such that NSCA might benefit from the attendance thereof of more than one person, the Board may, by motion, direct that two (2) NSCA delegates attend, and if the subject of the Curling Canada meeting or Congress is such that NSCA might benefit from the attendance thereof of a person with specialized knowledge that is not held by a Board member, then the Board may, by motion, authorize and secure the attendance thereof by such knowledgeable person as an observer.
