

INTERNATIONAL EXCHANGE TEAM SELECTION - OUT OF COUNTRY

Each Member Association may submit an equal number of applicants based on the total tour requirement.

Applications shall include résumés and be prioritized by the Member Association.

Equal representation, utilizing the Member Association priority, will be the first criterion. Further selection to complete the required team will be the responsibility of the Board of Governors. The Team Captain will be appointed by the Board of Governors.

When exchange tours are hosted in a specific region of Canada, the selection process for the next Canadian team may favour that region.

Member Association Priority shall be based on the following criteria:

- involvement and contribution to the sport of curling;
- be an active curler of a Curling Canada affiliated curling club;
- be physically fit (tours have exhausting schedules);
- be prepared to pay the estimated cost for travel, apparel, etc.;
- be prepared to sign the "Participant Agreement" governing apparel, travel arrangements, etc. (see attached)

The Canadian Tour Co-ordinator & Team Captain, appointed by Curling Canada shall be responsible for the overall planning for the Canadian Women's Team that will tour Scotland in November 2020. This includes all travel arrangements, team scheduling and decisions concerning official team clothing.

It is understood that the undersigned participant shall be responsible for all identified costs regarding the Tour.

It is further understood that the participant agrees to wear the official uniform, as requested, comply with travel arrangements made on their behalf and participate in all scheduled curling games and official social functions arranged as part of this International Curling Tour.
