I – POLICY

It is the policy of the NSCA to provide uniforms to sanctioned teams representing Nova Scotia in eligible National Championships when not supplied by Curling Canada.

II – SCOPE

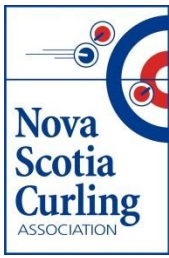
The following is a list of eligible events sanctioned by the Nova Scotia Curling Association under this policy (each team shall be considered to be Nova Scotia's representative at the listed event):

Provincial jackets will be provided to the Provincial Stick Open and the Provincial Stick Women Champions.

Affiliate Members of the NSCA are eligible to purchase the official provincial uniforms for their teams representing Nova Scotia at a National Championship.

III – PROCEDURE



1. The Nova Scotia Curling Association will provide to each player and the recognized coach of each provincial team with a set of Provincial Uniforms (unless provided by Curling Canada).

The Provincial Uniform will consist of one (1) Jacket with appropriate crestring and two (2) shirts with appropriate crestring. Extra shirts are available for purchase at NSCA pricing when purchased and paid for in advance of the national championship.

For events where sponsor crestring on jackets has been approved by Curling Canada, artwork must be provided to the Executive Director within three days of winning the provincial championship.
